# OFFICIAL DOG WALK VIDEO CONTEST RULES

1. **Eligibility.** This Contest is open only to Tigard residents. Those under 18 years of age will require signed consent of a parent or guardian.
2. **Contest Period.**
  - a. The contest opens February 6, 2015.
  - b. The contest entry period closes March 10, 2015.
  - c. An awards ceremony for the winners will take place on April 13, 2015, at the Tigard Library.
3. **Prizes for 3 Winners.** A gift certificate from area merchants in the amount of \$100 will be awarded to each of the creators of the three winning videos, as determined by two judging panels: The Tigard Dog Park Committee and the Tigard Youth Advisory Council. The Tigard Dog Park Committee will select finalists. The three winners from the finalists will be selected by the Tigard Youth Advisory Council.
4. **How to Enter.** Submit your video entry by email, or by mail or in person. You must submit a signed entry form by the March 10, 2015 deadline. You are welcome to submit just a URL for your videos published online, but we will still need a signed entry form from you.

  - **Mail/In-person:** For contestants submitting entries as CDs by surface mail or in-person, please return the signed entry form to: Tigard City Hall, c/o Dog Walk Video Contest, 13125 SW Hall Blvd., Tigard, Oregon 97223
5. **Deadline for Submission.**
  - Signed entries submitted in person or received by mail/in-person: 5 p.m., March 10, 2015.
  - Signed entries submitted as URLs by email: Midnight, March 10, 2015.
6. **Winner Selection.** Winners will be determined by April 3, 2015, by the final judging panel. All decisions are final. Winners will be notified by phone or email. Only one prize is given per contestant.
7. Award winners must continue to comply with all terms and conditions of these official rules and winning is contingent upon fulfilling all requirements. In the event that a winner of an award is disqualified for any reason, the judges will select an alternate winner.
8. Each winner is responsible for all taxes, fees and costs associated with prize receipt and/or use.
9. The event organizers, City of Tigard, reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to disqualify any entry that it believes violates any of the rules for this contest or is otherwise not consistent with the spirit and theme of the contest.
10. Videos must not contain material that violate or infringe on another's rights, including but not limited to material that violates privacy, publicity, or intellectual property rights. The City will not consider contestant entries that contain copyrighted material. Do not include footage or images of any persons in your video, including but not limited to minors, who have not expressly authorized you to display their image, likeness, or voice in any submitted video. The City has the right to refuse entries which are or promote activities which are violent, discriminatory, or illegal.
11. The City of Tigard assumes no ownership or responsibility for all video contest entries or liability for video work created by participants. Filmmakers retain all copyright and ownership of their work, but grant to the City of Tigard a non-exclusive license to reproduce, distribute, display, transmit, or disseminate the entry for the purposes of judging entries. All film submissions shared in analog form on a CD will not be rebroadcast by the City of Tigard, except at the awards ceremony. CD copies will be destroyed after the contest.
12. By uploading files to YouTube or Vimeo as part of the contest, contestants agree and acknowledge to abide by publishing terms managed by either platform and all U.S. and international copyright laws. Contest entries posted on YouTube or Vimeo will remain the property of the publishers, who have full responsibility and ownership over their published work. As a condition for entering the contest, the City of Tigard will be allowed to link to any video published online as an official entry and to broadcast/show all contest entries, in CD or YouTube and Vimeo-enabled formats, as part of the contest on the video contest ceremony date.
13. By entering, each contestant agrees to comply with and be bound by these official rules and the decisions of the judging panels, which are binding and final in all matters relating to this contest, and release and hold harmless the organizers and any other organization responsible for sponsoring, fulfilling, administering, advertising or promoting the contest (collectively, the "released parties") from and against any and all claims, expenses and liability.
14. BY PARTICIPATING IN THIS CONTEST, CONTESTANTS AGREE THAT THE CITY OF TIGARD WILL HAVE NO LIABILITY WHATSOEVER FOR, AND SHALL BE HELD HARMLESS BY ENTRANTS AGAINST, ANY LIABILITY FOR ANY INJURIES, LOSSES, OR DAMAGES OF ANY KIND TO PERSONS, INCLUDING PERSONAL INJURY OR DEATH, OR PROPERTY RESULTING IN WHOLE OR IN PART, DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY, FROM ENTRY OR PARTICIPATION IN THIS CONTEST OR IN ANY CONTEST-RELATED ACTIVITY, OR ANY CLAIMS BASED ON PUBLICITY RIGHTS, DEFAMATION, OR INVASION OF PRIVACY, OR MERCHANDISE DELIVERY. By entering this contest, each contestant represents and warrants that his or her entry does not and will not defame or otherwise violate the rights of any third party and does not and will not violate any federal, state, or local laws or ordinances. Contestant further represents and warrants that he or she has secured the requisite consent from any third party referenced or appearing in his or her video. To the extent that anyone under the age of 18 appears in a video, contestant represents and warrants that the minor's parents consented to the minor's appearance in the video and the public display of the video.
15. **General Conditions.** The City of Tigard reserves the right to cancel, suspend and/or modify the contest, or any part of it, without notice, if any factor beyond its reasonable control impairs the integrity of the Contest, as determined by the City of Tigard in its discretion.
