

SMOKING

HISTORY: Smoking is against the law in public buildings in the State of Oregon. ORS 433.835.870 states a person may not smoke or carry any lighted smoking instrument in a public place or within 10 feet of the entrance to a public place. This would include cigarettes, pipes, cigars, or other smoking instruments.

POLICY: As of July 1, 2010, Tigard Library policy is that smokers have to be 45 feet away from any entrance to the building. The ash tray is located beyond the black bollards at the Library entrance. Smoking is not allowed in the Courtyard. This policy is visible on the window at both the entrance to the Library and the courtyard.
