A registration fee of \$20 per child (*additional siblings from the same family are \$15 each*) can be paid at check-in.

The parent or responsible adult should return at noon to rejoin the child and participate in a review of the curriculum together. This will last no longer than 30 minutes. The recap will help reinforce the information presented throughout the morning. We appreciate your cooperation in our efforts to make this program as effective as possible for your child. Where: **Tigard City Hall, 13125 SW Hall Blvd., in Town Hall**

Purpose: To provide children ages 8–11 with tools to stay safe at home when unsupervised. Children will learn about indoor and outdoor safety, first aid, emergency situations and much more. This knowledge will help parents feel at ease when work schedules conflict with non-school days. It also provides better safety measures whenever children are in a home, including watching out for siblings.



Classes fill quickly – so act now!

Partner with the Tigard Police Department in an effort to empower your child. Officer Kristan Rinell, a certified safety instructor, will teach children ways to be safe whenever they are home alone, or home with other children when no adult supervision is present. This is a must for working parents. Give your children the added confidence knowing they can do the right thing and stay safe when unattended at home.

A COMPLETED REGISTRATION FORM IS REQUIRED. An email confirmation will be sent after processing, subject to space availability. Class size is restricted to better control the messaging and curriculum. The cost is \$20 per child—a second child within the same family is charged \$15. All materials and a mid-morning snack are included.
