Mr. Frewing addressed the Board and asked the Board to advocate against a Fanno Creek Trail crossing on Hall Blvd with a short trail and bridge on Fanno Creek Park north of the Library.

Secondly, Mr. Frewing suggested that the Fanno Creek Trail segment from Bonita Road along 74th Street to Durham Road should run along the railroad tracks, or look into negotiating with property owners to obtain wetlands.

5. **Park System Master Plan Update.** Conducted one focus group meeting with recreation providers. Conducted stakeholder interviews. We have begun to receive questionnaires from sports groups and the general community. The next major task will be the community survey.
