A RESOLUTION OF THE TIGARD CITY COUNCIL SUPPORTING AN APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL ASSISTANCE FOR CONSTRUCTING SIDEWALK AND RELATED IMPROVEMENTS ALONG PORTIONS OF SW HALL AND KNOLL STREETS

WHEREAS, Community Partners for Affordable Housing has received land use approval to construct a 48-unit senior housing project on a one acre site in Tigard; and

WHEREAS, all units will be affordable for individuals and households earning less than 50% of area median income; and

WHEREAS, the installation of sidewalks and associated improvements is a condition of the project's land use approval; and

WHEREAS, these improvements are identified in an application for federal Community Block Grant funds; and

WHEREAS, these improvements meet the national and county Community Development Block Grant objective of serving persons having low and moderate incomes; and

WHEREAS, Washington County will receive an estimated two million for fiscal year 2009/10, for which nine cities, the county, and various non-profit agencies will compete for the funding of eligible projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tigard City Council that:


SECTION 1: The City of Tigard hereby expresses its support for making improvements to SW Hall and Knoll Streets and authorizes submission of an application for federal assistance.
