IN ARREARS FOR TRAFFIC FINES)

Any clerk of the court may reinstate a traffic defendant's right to drive in Oregon through the Division of Drivers and Motor Vehicles (DMV) when a defendant does all of the following:


1. Pays one-half the current judgment balance or \$500.00 (cash, money order or certified check), whichever is less;
2. Pays the court reinstatement fee in the sum of \$15.00; and,
3. Executes a new payment agreement for the unpaid balance.

Defendants owing less than \$300.00 must pay the full balance due and the court reinstatement fee before the court will issue a reinstatement order.

If a defendant fails to comply with all provisions of the new payment agreement, the court may suspend that defendant's right to drive in Oregon through DMV without further notice.

Applications for exceptions to this rule shall be presented to the judge for consideration.
