

**TIGARD MUNICIPAL COURT**  
**Possible Community Service Options**



The following is a list of groups that have agreed to work with youth assigned community service hours. These sites may have restrictions for the worker. Restrictions can be based on age or type of offense. The agency must know, before you begin your community service, that you are fulfilling a court requirement.

**You are not required to work for one of the listed agencies.** You may find your own community service placement. Other ideas include senior centers, nursing homes, schools, churches or other non-profit agencies in your area. (Again, make sure the agency knows, before you begin your community service, that you are fulfilling a court requirement.)
