

Rules and Guidelines
City of Tigard
Water Conservation Poster Contest

This year's slogan:
“Think green, go blue. Conserve water!”

1. The contest is open to elementary students (first through fifth grade) currently enrolled in a school within the Tigard Water Service Area, or students who live within the city's water service boundaries.
2. Entries will be judged on the following criteria:
 - ◆ Theme expression
 - ◆ Originality/creativity
 - ◆ Neatness/artistic execution
3. The fourteen winning posters will be included in the 2010 water conservation calendar to be distributed by the City of Tigard.
4. Artwork must be on 8 ½” x 11” paper and have a completed entry form taped to the back of the poster. (It is sometimes helpful to fill out classroom information on master copy and then make copies for students.) Please include your classroom/contact phone number in case names of students need to be verified.
5. **Posters must be drawn horizontally.**
6. Artwork:
 - ◆ Should contain bright colors.
 - ◆ Can be created from colored pencils, markers, crayons, poster paint, ink, pencil, and/or watercolors.
 - ◆ Writing should be large with a short message.
 - ◆ Must be original artwork (computer or trademarked art will be disqualified).
7. All entries will become the property of the City of Tigard and may be used in other promotions without further permission and/or compensation to the artist.
8. Entries must be turned in no later than Thursday, **April 30, 2009**. Please send/deliver entries to:
