Tigard Pedestrian Crosswalk Enforcement Yields 21 Citations

On Thursday, September 11th, Tigard Police conducted a focused pedestrian crosswalk enforcement. The effort is to help raise awareness regarding pedestrian laws through enforcement and education. The grant-funded enforcement campaign took place at the intersection of Greenburg Rd and Center St. in Tigard.

Over the three-hour period, Tigard officers conducted 22 traffic stops. Of those, 14 drivers were issued citations for failure to stop and remain stopped for pedestrians (ORS 811.028). Other violations resulting in the issuance of citations or warnings include: 3 citations issued for failure to obey a traffic control device; 1 citation for driving while suspended; 1 citation for operating a vehicle without driving privileges; 1 citation for driving uninsured and 1 citation for failure to use a seatbelt.
