Neighborhood Network

Purpose:

The Neighborhood Network Annual Event is designed to bring neighbors together to get to know each other, strengthen connections and communication and foster community-building activities. Each Neighborhood Network is encouraged to sponsor one annual event each year. Examples include picnics, parades, block parties, etc.

Eligible Activities:

In order to be eligible for city funds, neighborhood events must meet the following guidelines:

- All residents of the neighborhood area are invited to attend
- No alcohol will be served
- No commercial advertising or vendors
- The event/activity must be held on public property (i.e. park, school)

Process:

All residents and property owners shall have an opportunity to nominate and provide input on suggested Neighborhood Network Annual Events. Thirty to 60 days in advance of the annual meeting, nominations shall be called for on the Neighborhood Networks' web page and in the Cityscape. Consideration of the activities shall be listed as a topic on the annual meeting notice mailed to all residents. All nominated event activities meeting established criteria must be presented and considered at the Neighborhood Network's annual meeting. The Neighborhood Network shall sponsor the project supported by the majority of residents. Residents may register their support at the annual meeting or on-line within established time frames.

If there is not clear support for one project, the Steering Committee shall make the final selection.
