Annual Trick or Treat Returns to Main Street

The City of Tigard and the Tigard Downtown Alliance are teaming up to host a safe and enjoyable Trick or Treat Main Street celebration that promises fun for families and kids of all ages.

The activities take place on Halloween Day, Oct. 31, from 4 to 6 p.m. Kids and adults are encouraged to dress up as their favorite character and enjoy trick or treating at businesses on Main Street in downtown Tigard.

Supported by downtown Tigard merchants, the family-friendly event remains one of Tigard's most popular community fests. Each year, hundreds of kids dress up with their parents to make stops along Main Street.

In Halloween tradition, Main Street merchants will don costumes and stand outside their shops handing candy out to trick or treaters. Participating downtown merchants will have a smiling orange pumpkin poster in their windows.
