Share Your Views at Budget and Brews this Thursday

Tigard's Budget and Brews events are designed to connect residents, business owners and others interested in local government with city leaders. The brief sessions, held at local coffee houses and pubs, provide information about city services, service delivery and funding sources—with a focus on the city's current financial challenge to maintain funding for day-to-day services at current levels.

“Our goals are simple,” said City Manager Marty Wine. “We want to offer people an opportunity to learn more about how our city operates, ensure that we at the city understand our residents’ thoughts with regard to what services are important to them, and find sustainable solutions for our budget situation.”

The city has already hosted two Budget and Brews events this summer, and a third is happening this Thursday, Aug. 10, at Max's Fanno Creek Bew Pub, at 7 p.m.

City staff will provide snacks, soft drinks and a brief background on a budget-related topic and then facilitate a discussion to engage the audience on their perspective.

“It's important for us to know what people are thinking about city services and how we should move forward,” said Wine.
