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## **IRS Provides Limited Tax Forms To Libraries**

The Internal Revenue Service (IRS) has sent a limited number of tax forms to libraries this year and no instruction booklets. The Tigard Library has received 1040, 1040A and 1040EZ forms. According to the IRS, they have reduced the number of tax forms and publications significantly because Congress drastically cut their appropriations in the 2015 budget.

The library will make available copies of some forms that are most in demand such as Itemized Deductions(Schedule A), Capital Gains and Losses(Schedule D) and Interest and Ordinary Dividends(Schedule B). People may make photocopies of other forms from the library's master file or print them off the Web at [www.irs.gov/forms](http://www.irs.gov/forms) at 10 cents a page.

They may also call the IRS at 1-800-829-3676 for a mailed copy. The state of Oregon has not provided state forms for several years. For more tax information people can log onto <http://www.wccls.org/taxhelp>

"We are sorry for any inconvenience this has caused," said Library Director Margaret Barnes. "Tax time is often stressful, and we are committed to helping people access what they need to do their taxes."
