

## HERITAGE TREE PROGRAM

This program may offer incentives to landowners who protect Heritage Trees growing on their property. The Heritage Tree track provides city assistance for maintenance in exchange for regulatory protection. Incentives offered include permanent financial and technical assistance with tree maintenance and preservation. Trees on city property are also eligible for the Heritage Tree designation.

Each Heritage Tree will be identified with a plaque and included on the city's Heritage Tree and Significant Tree Map. The city currently has the capacity to designate up to two Heritage and Significant Trees Map per year.

## SIGNIFICANT TREE PROGRAM

The Significant Tree track allows trees to be publically recognized without regulatory restrictions. Significant Trees are not eligible for city assistance for maintenance because property owners are allowed to remove the tree at any time.

Each Significant Tree will be included on the city's Heritage Tree and Significant Trees Map.

All nominations will be reviewed by the Tigard City Arborist, the Tree Board and ultimately the City Council.
