Suspect Arrested After Taking Up-Skirt Photos of Women

A 24 year-old Tualatin man was arrested Saturday at a clothing store located at Washington Square Mall in Tigard. The suspect, Ignacio Manuel Napoles-Cinto was allegedly taking photos of unsuspecting women who were shopping. Tigard Police were called to the H&M retailer at approximately 2:20 p.m. on August 8th after store security detained Napoles-Cinto. A short time earlier, two young girls reported to H&M security seeing a man positioning a phone under women's skirts.

Tigard Police do not know the identity of the women who were photographed-at least fifteen at some point during that day. Cell phone video depicts the victims were likely photographed at multiple locations. Tigard Police would like to hear from anyone who may have observed the suspect (photo attached) at any point at Washington Square on Saturday, August 8th. Cinto was lodged in the Washington County Jail in Hillsboro and charged with 15 counts of Invasion of Personal Privacy. Recently, Oregon Legislators passed a bill which criminalized photographing under skirts or dresses unknowingly to the victim.
