Tigard Police Commercial Crimes Unit Recovers Over 100K of Stolen Property

On August 10th, Tigard Police served a search warrant at a home located on the 10800 block of SW Canterbury Lane in Tigard. The home was the subject of a search to recover merchandise fraudulently obtained from the Williams Sonoma retail store located at the Washington Square Mall. In the search, Tigard Police investigators seized over \$100,000 worth of merchandise in the home known to be part of an alleged internal theft involving online purchasing and fraudulent refunds without returning the items. That figure could double or more as investigators continue to probe further.

An employee of the Williams Sonoma store, 40 year-old Cameron Gray was arrested at the Tigard retail store as Tigard Police initiated the search at his Tigard residence. Another person allegedly involved in the scam, 21 year-old Eric Wiley, was home when police arrived and was also arrested. Both suspects are charged with Aggravated Theft I and were lodged in the Washington County Jail.

During the search of the residence, police seized over 200 items which had previously been identified by a loss prevention investigation conducted by Williams Sonoma. All the recovered property was transferred to Williams Sonoma company representatives. The preliminary investigational reports have been forwarded to the Washington County District Attorney's office for review.
