Auto-Pedestrian Crash Critically Injures Man

A 9-1-1 call sent Tigard Police to the scene of an auto-pedestrian crash at 6:05 a.m. on Tuesday, June 28. Tigard Police officers immediately rendered aid to the victim as well as redirected the quickly swelling traffic along Pacific Highway at Dartmouth Ave. Washington County CART arrived shortly after and began the crash investigation.

Witness statements provided to police indicated the victim, 32 year-old Jonathan Allen, appeared to attempt to cross Pacific Highway with disregard to traffic moving with a green light. In doing so, Allen was struck by a vehicle traveling northbound. The driver involved stopped and remained at the scene. Allen was transported by ambulance to OHSU with apparent life-threatening injuries.

Northbound traffic along Pacific Highway was rerouted near the crash scene as police investigated the crash. Additionally, the exit to Pacific Highway from northbound Hwy 217 was closed approximately 2 hours while the crash investigation ensued. As a result, extensive traffic delays resulted during the morning commute along Pacific Highway and stretches of Hwy 217 in Tigard.
