TechnARTology Show SUBMISSION RULES

- The show is open to teens in grades 6–12.
- One entry per person, please.
- Entries must be a reasonable size for library display (no bigger than a shoebox if three-dimensional.)
- Entrants must credit other artists' work if integrated into their submission.
- Entries may be displayed in the library and posted on Facebook.
- Winners will be announced on Monday, March 7, and on display March 6–12. Entrants can pick up their submissions afterward.
- Entrants authorize the library to display images of their artwork in informal publications or on the library's website, with appropriate credit to the artist.
- The library is not responsible for damage to entries. The art show is in a public space and will be supervised but not secured.

Submission of an entry to the contest automatically constitutes acceptance of all conditions set forth in the above rules. Entries that do not comply with these rules will not be considered for exhibit.
