WIN Detectives Seize Quarter Pound of Cocaine - 3 in Custody

On Thursday, October 30, 2008 at approximately 5:45 AM, members of the Washington County Tactical Negotiations Team (TNT) along with officers from the Tigard Police Department served a search warrant at a residence in the Bonita Villa Apartments located at 7580 SW Bonita Rd. in Tigard OR. The warrant culminated an ongoing investigation by the Westside Interagency Narcotics Team (WIN) into the distribution of cocaine and methamphetamine.

Detectives had been investigating the sale of the illegal narcotics and had evidence that such activity was occurring in the complex. Neighbors commented that they had suspected such activity due to the continuous traffic in and out of the complex at all hours. As a result of the warrant, investigators seized from the apartment approximately one quarter pound of cocaine, one half pound of cutting agent for cocaine distribution as well as packaging material and scales.

3 adult males were taken into custody and lodged in the Washington County Jail.

- Pelaez-Moreno, Jose (05.25.85) was charged with Possession, Manufacture and Distribution of controlled substances / cocaine.
- Herrera-Moreno, Andres (01.30.73) was charged with Criminal Possession of a Forged Instrument.
- Camacho-Noguera, Ismael (01.08.56) was charged with Criminal Possession of a Forged Instrument.
