How You Will Make a Difference

Book Reviewers play a pivotal role in encouraging other people to read the same fun books from our library catalog that you're reading.

Volunteers are needed to:

- Sign up on under “Remote Volunteer Program: Library” on VicNet.
- Write a book review following these guidelines
 - Book review must be one paragraph long
 - Include a short summary of the book
 - Write about what you liked or disliked about the book
 - Avoid spoilers
- Send your review to Katie or Lisa to review.
- Once you hear from the librarian, post your review on our library catalog, wcls.bibliocommons.com
 - Give it an Age rating and a Star rating
 - Make sure your review is made public so that it can be seen
- Fill out a Volunteer Reflection form and send to Volunteer Coordinator Katie.
