Driver Arrested For DUII After Crashing and Eluding Police

On Friday, March 10th, a 37 year-old Tualatin woman was taken into custody after eluding Tigard Police. The incident began at approximately 6:25 p.m. when a Tigard restaurant employee called police to report an unwanted and intoxicated subject inside the restaurant.

A Tigard Police officer arrived shortly after and located the subject seated in a parked vehicle just outside the restaurant entrance. When the officer attempted to make contact, the suspect sped off. The officer pursued the suspect vehicle for a period as it traveled southbound along Pacific Highway through Tigard and into Tualatin. Once the suspect vehicle slowed due to traffic, the officer following was able to force the vehicle to a near stop however the driver jumped a curb and crashed into two vehicles which were unoccupied and parked at an auto sales business located at 17835 SW Pacific Highway in Tualatin.

Tigard Police took the driver, identified as Christine Foe into custody. Foe was charged with DUII, Felony Elude, Reckless Driving and Reckless Endangering. There were no injuries reported.
