Additional Program Information

- We have added a "neutral exit" category, which refers to folks who decide to leave the program on their own and have stated they are able to self-resolve their own situation or need to move due to other factors. For example, we have had individuals leave the program because there is a family emergency they need to attend elsewhere, they have found a job that takes them to a different community, or they feel that the program is not the right fit for them. Folks that chose to leave the program are provided with resources for services that may better fit their needs and advised on local ordinances around parking/camping.
